

ORDINANCE NO. 4 SERIES 2011

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING IN PART ORDINANCE 3, SERIES 2002
OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDSOR**

ADOPTED THE 5th DAY OF DECEMBER, 2011

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public and the Village that Ordinance 3, Series 2002, Section IV be amended;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDSOR, NOW NEW WINDSOR, MERCER COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ORDINANCE NUMBER 3, SERIES 2002 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1.00. SECTION IV: LIMITATIONS ON BURNING, subparagraph (a) shall be deleted and substituted in its place the following:

(a) So long as not prohibited by the Village Police Chief or Fire Chief, the burning of leaves and yard materials shall be permitted by residents of the Village between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday, so long as such burning is attended to by an adult at all times. Such leaf burning shall be done so as not to cause damage to any street or avenue or to endanger any person or property.

2.00. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, all as provided by law.

3.00. No provision of this Ordinance shall be construed as repealing or effecting any




